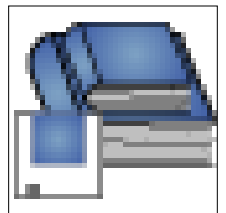

Find Books using the Catalog

If the book is a print source, you'll be told its:

- **STATUS** Is it available and on the shelves, or checked out?
- **LOCATION** e.g., Main Stacks, Reference, Reserve
- **CALL NUMBER** The alpha-numeric on the spine of the book that shows **where** it is shelved, as well as the **subject** area. **Browse the shelves.**
- **No call number information or [“Access this electronic book via the Internet”](#)**
- You have accessed an **electronic book**. E- books are the same content as print books.
- Read them 24/7 online. Searchable. Can email and print portions.
- You need to use your library card number to read them.

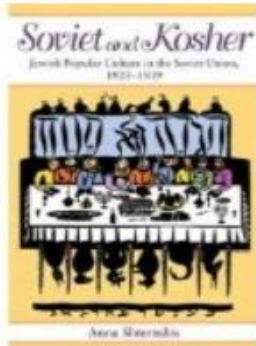

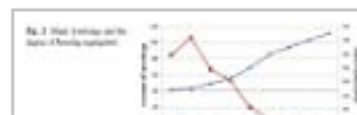
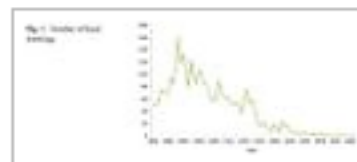
