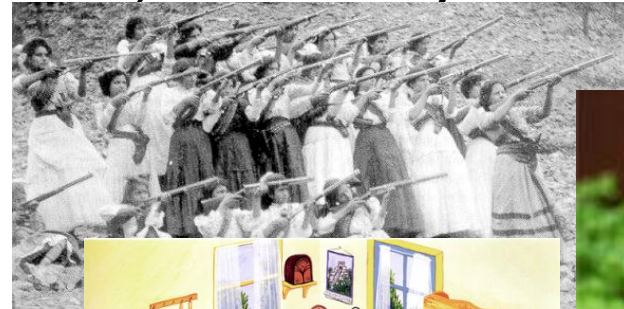

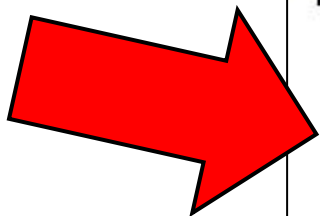

An August 2003 lawsuit filed by the parents of two teenage girls claimed that McDonald's was deceptive regarding the effects of their food and should therefore be held responsible for the girls' health problems, which included obesity, diabetes, high blood pressure and cholesterol, and heart disease. Although Judge Robert Sweet ruled in favor of McDonald's, stating that the plaintiffs failed to show that the products consumed were "dangerous in any way other than that which was open and obvious to a reasonable consumer," the lawsuit raised the question: Who is responsible for childhood obesity? 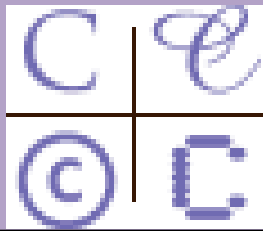

Domestic violence, also called domestic abuse or intimate partner violence, refers to abusive actions between people who are in a past or present close relationship. The Office on Violence Against Women, part of the U.S. Department of Justice, defines domestic abuse as "a pattern of abusive behavior in any relationship that can be used by one partner to gain or maintain power and control over another intimate partner." The abuse can take physical, emotional, sexual, or psychological forms. Domestic violence occurs between people who are married, unmarried, or just dating. Academic Search Premier- Full text for nearly 4,700 primarily scholarly publications, and indexing for an additional 4,000 titles.

Alt HealthWatch - Contains full text for 180 publications and many other sources covering non-traditional and alternative medicine topics.

CINAHL PLUS with Full text - Provides indexing for over 3000 journals in nursing and allied health, plus full text for over 300 journals.

Health Source Nursing/Academic - Provides nearly 550 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines, and includes the Clinical Pharmacology database.

Medline - Provides abstracts from over 4,800 current biomedical journals, including citations from Index Medicus, Index to Dental Literature, and more.

Evaluation: Web Sites

If you have an article published in a peer-reviewed online journal, you're good to go.

However...

No content, nor publication standards on the web.

Anyone can publish, and DOES!

Remember your questions about

Content

Credibility

Timeliness

Additional questions to ask...

- Does the site link to other credible sources?
- Have cited references?
- Are the author's credentials listed?
- Mission statement/"about us" link for the organization?
- Published by reputable organization's web site?
- Biased? One point of view?
- Personal/monetary gain?
- Commercial ads?
- Poor spelling or grammar?
- Current? Check for updates or copyright date (usually at bottom of page)

Sexual Assault

Also called: Rape



Sexual assault is any sexual activity to which you haven't freely given your consent. This includes completed or attempted sex acts that are against your will. Sometimes it can involve a victim who is unable to consent. It also includes abusive sexual contact. It can happen to men, women or [children](#).

The attacker can be anyone - a current or former partner, a family member, a person in position of power or trust, a friend, an acquaintance, or a stranger.

Sexual assault can affect your health in many ways. It can lead to long-term health and emotional problems. It is important to seek help if you have been assaulted. First, get to a safe place. Then dial 911 or go to a hospital for medical care. You may want to have counseling to deal with your feelings. The most important thing to know

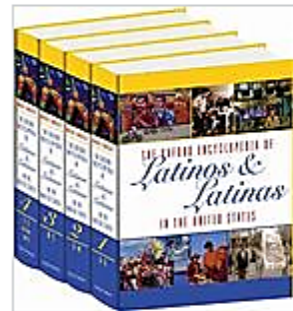
